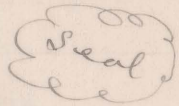
That we have caused the same to be laid out with lots and numbered as shown on said Plat. That we hereby dedicate the street and alleys as shown hereon to public use.

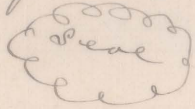
