Gentlemen:-

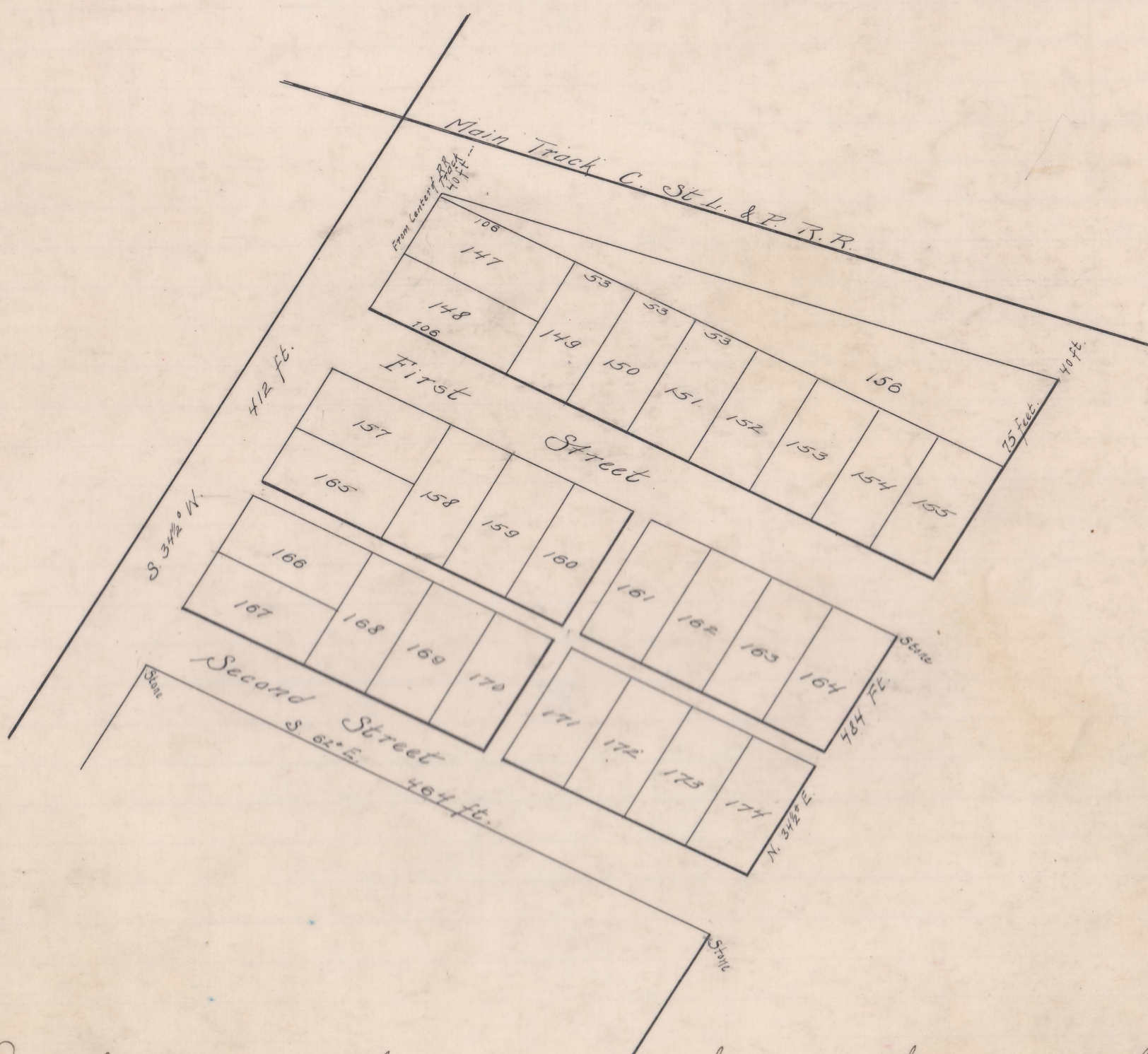

In the matter of annexing territory to Milford Center.  
A Petition having been filed at the December session 1890. by F. Boylan setting forth that he is the owner of certain lands, adjoining the Corporation of Milford Center. That said lands are unoccupied and that he desires to have the same annexed to said Village, together with an accurate description of said lands and a plot thereof and this being the day appointed for the hearing.  
Thereupon the cause came on to be heard. The Commissioners having found that the petition contained all the matter required. That its statements are true and that due notice of the pending of such petition had been given according to law. ordered (on motion of Brannan) that the said land be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Milford Center.

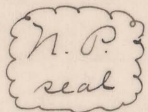
