

R. P. Mann's
in Addition to
Milford

I hereby certify that on the 22^d day of March A.D. 1866. I made a Survey of an addition to the town of Milford Union County Ohio for Elizabeth Mann Widow and devise of R.P. Mann dec'd: of the lands embraced in the following description. To Wit: Beginning at a stake in the south line of Survey N^o 5127. and 4 poles and 4 links N 76 1/2° W. from a stone marked thus + the north east corner to Survey N^o 9591. Said stake is the southwest corner of a 1 acre lot sold to Hiram Stokes by R.P. Mann. Thence with the west line of said 1 acre lot N 21 1/4° E 20 poles + 9 links to a stake. Thence with the north line of said 1 acre

lot, S70° E 4 poles + 22 links to a stake, Southwest corner to Sarah Reynolds lot. Thence with the west line of said lot N. 22° E 5 poles + 7 links to a stake corner to said lot. Thence with her north line S71° E. 24 feet to the west line of a lot sold by R. P. Mann to Elias Topliff. Thence with said line N19° E 20 feet to a stake 2 feet easterly of the southwest corner of in lot N^o 1. in the town of Milford. Thence with the south line of lots in said town N71° W. 13 poles + 15 links to a stake in the east line of the C. C. & C. Railroad lands, 100 feet at right angles from the center of the track. Thence with said line S40° W 18 poles + 9 links to a stake in the west line of Out Lot N^o 1 and 100 feet at right angles from center of the track of said Railroad. Thence with the west line of said Out Lot N^o 1. S11½° W. 9 poles + 18 links to a stake in the south line of Survey N^o 5127. Bring the southwest corner of Out Lot N^o 1. Thence with said Survey line S76½° E. 11 poles to the beginning. Excepting therefrom the lands embraced in lots N^{os} 46 + 47 (heretofore sold by R. P. Mann to Daniel Egan and Catherine Diggins) containing 1¾ acres.

For further description reference may be made to the above plat which is a correct representation of said addition.

Mann has heretofore sold to Elias Topliff, Sarah Reynolds, Hiram Stokes, Daniel Egan, Caroline Diggins and R. R. Co. And I do dedicate to public use the said Alley as represented upon the above plat. Which plat is made and hereto attached for the purpose of record.
