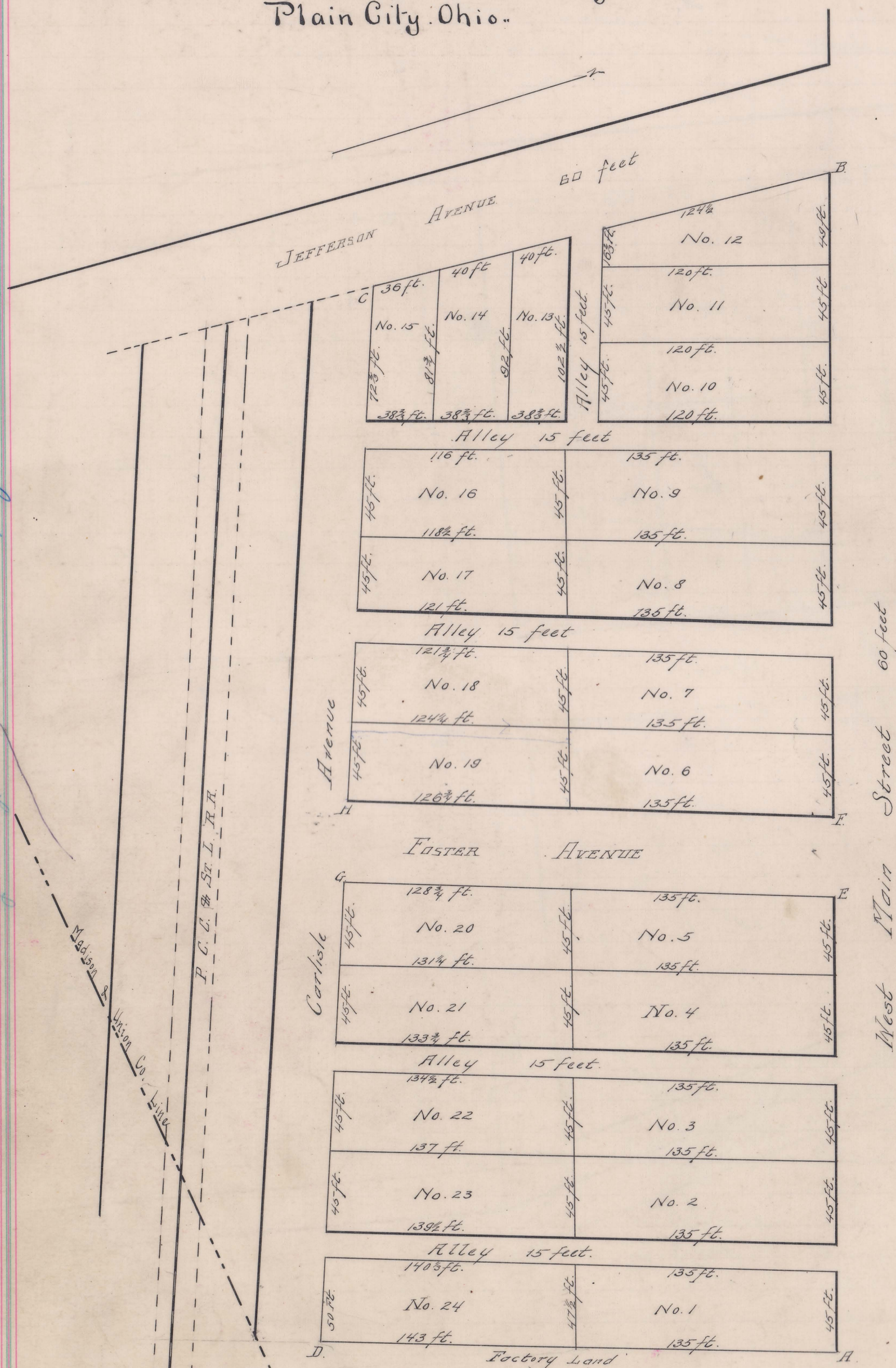


Plat of Howard C. Black's.
Columbian Addition to the Village of ~~~
Plain City, Ohio.



Howard C. Black's Columbian Addition to Plain City, Union County Ohio.

Said Addition is situate in the Township of Jerome, County of Union and State of Ohio. It being a parcel of land formerly owned by Howard C. Black containing four (4) acres and one hundred and forty three (143) poles (Including the part in the roads) and in Survey N^o. 7758.

Said addition is predicated upon tile planted at "A" and an iron Pin

planted at "B" And further upon the tile planted at C-D-E-F & G. Lots Nos. 1 & 2 inclusive front on West Main Street. Lot N^o 1 is 45 feet front & running back at a right angle with West Main Street, 135 feet and is 47½ ft. wide on the back end. Lots Nos 2-3-4-5-6-7-8 & 9 are each 45 feet in width and 135 feet in length. Lots Nos. 10 & 11 are each 45 feet wide & 120 feet in depth. Lot N^o 12 is 49 feet wide in front, 120 feet deep on the east side, 16½ feet wide on the back side and 124½ feet on Jefferson Avenue. Lot N^o 13 is 40 feet wide on Jefferson Avenue, 92 feet deep on the south side, 38½ feet wide on the back end and 102½ feet deep on the north side. Lot N^o 14 is 40 feet on Jefferson Avenue, 81½ feet on the South side, 38½ feet on the back side and 92 feet on the North side. Lot N^o 15 is 36 feet on Jefferson Avenue, 72½ feet on Carlisle Avenue 38½ feet on the back end and 81¾ feet on the north side. Lot N^o 16 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 118½ feet on the east side, 45 feet on the back side and 116 feet on the West side. Lot N^o 17 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 121 feet on the East side, 45 feet on the back side and 118½ feet on the West side. Lot N^o 18 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 124½ feet on the east side 45 feet on the back side & 124½ feet on the west side. Lot N^o 19 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 126¾ feet on Foster Avenue, 45 feet on the back side & 124½ feet on the West side. Lot N^o 20 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 131½ feet on the east side, 45 feet on the back side and 128¾ feet on Foster Avenue. Lot N^o 21 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 133¾ feet on the east side, 45 feet on the back side, 131½ feet on the west side. Lot N^o 22 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 137 feet on the east side, 45 feet on the back side and 134½ feet on the West side. Lot N^o 23 is 45 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 139½ feet on the East side, 45 feet on the back side and 137 feet on the West side. Lot N^o 24 is 50 feet on Carlisle Avenue, 143 feet on the East side, 47½ feet on the back side and 140½ feet on the west side. Lots 13-14 & 15 front on Jefferson Avenue. Lots 16 to 24 inclusive front on Carlisle Avenue. Foster & Carlisle Avenues are each 40 feet in width, all the alleys are 15 feet in width. On West Main Street & Jefferson Avenue the lots are laid off allowing for a 60 foot street and are fronting 30 feet from the middle of the streets respectively.

I hereby certify that the above description and accompanying plat is an accurate description of the property sought to be added to the Incorporated Village of Plain City. Dated at Plain City Ohio, this 1st day of June 1893.
