


Plat of

I hereby certify that on the 4th day of May 1883 I made a Survey of an Addition to the Village of Unionville and laid out into Town Lots for Hattie V. Dockum, the following Described Premises, Being part of O.U.M. Survey No. 5724 And commencing in the center of the Grand Road leading from the Village of Unionville to the Depot and known as Railroad Street, at the point where the line between Survey Nos. 7245 & 5124 crosses said street thence with the center of said street northerly to a point opposite the south margin of Third Street in the Village of Unionville. Thence with the south margin of Third Street easterly to a point opposite the east margin of Cross St. Thence continuing with the course of the margin of Cross St. southerly parallel with Railroad Street to the line between Surv. Nos. 7245 & 5724. thence with said Survey line to the place of Beginning containing 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ one half acres of Land more or less. And to be known as Dockum's Addition to Unionville. For further description Reference is hereby made to the above Plat which is a correct representation of said Addition. — F.J. Sager. County Surveyor —

I know all now by these Presents, that Mr. Lester T. Dockum and Hattie V. Dockum his wife of the Village of Unionville, County of Union, State of Ohio, have caused the above described premises to be laid out into lots as represented upon the above plat, under name of Dockum's Addition to the Village of Unionville, and further Mr. Hattie V. Dockum and Lester T. Dockum her husband do hereby dedicate to public use the streets and alleys as shown upon said plat.
