


Plat  
of the Town of  
Union Center.

Taylor Township.



J. B. J. Fay, Surveyor in and for the County of Union, Surveyed the town of Union Center, in Taylor Township in Union County Illino. November 9<sup>th</sup> & December 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>, 1863. for H. P. Goff, Hiram Danforth, Ira T. Robbins & Mary S. Robbins his wife and Charles J. Sayre Attorney in fact for William Sayre. And the persons above named and Adeline D. Goff, wife of said H. P. Goff, Matilda S. Danforth wife of said Hiram Danforth & Gratia B. Sayre wife of said William Sayre do hereby set apart the following premises to be named as above stated the Town of Union Center to wit: Part of Survey No. 829. Beginning at a stone planted at the intersection of the Kinton with the Delaware & Bellefontaine roads. running from thence for said Danforth & Goff with the Kinton road. N 16° W. 28 poles & from the same point of intersection with the Delaware & Bellefontaine road for Danforth S 72 1/2° W. 28 p. & for Goff N 72 1/2° E. 28 p. & thence by parallel lines with the first two lines each 28 poles including for said Danforth & Goff each 4 144/60 acres & running from said point of intersection for said Sayre & Robbins with the center of said Kinton road. S 16° E. 28 poles and with the center of said Delaware & Bellefontaine road for Robbins S 72 1/2° W. 28 poles & for Sayre N 72 1/2° E. 28 poles and then by parallel lines with the first two mentioned lines 28 poles each. including for the said Sayre & Robbins each 4 144/60 acres. Stones are planted at the points lettered from T to Y. and all the stones have brick under them except at T. B. L. D. E. F. G. & H. and stones with pieces of brick

under them are planted at the corners marked with a cross, thus X.  
The entire plat containing  $19 \frac{9}{60}$  acres. The lots are all  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  poles by 10  
poles, the width of the streets, sidewalks & alleys are as designated  
upon the above plat.
