Plat of the Town of Frank Port

April 1st 1846

Surveyed and laid out the Town of Frank Port in Jerome Township Union County Ohio on Survey No 2991. Making the centre of the Dublin Road the centre of Main Street laying Main Street 60 feet wide with a said walk of 8 feet on each side the course being N 9° 15' W or S 9° 15' E and Town Street 60 feet wide crossing Main at right angles course being N 80° 45' E or S 80° 45' W the course of all the lots being the same on the Streets five Blocks of lots on each side of Main Street Each Block being 2 lots wide as marked on the Plat and two lots deep the front lots running ten Rods from the centre of the street the back lots ten poles long with a reserve of 30 feet on the Back end for a street when needed a stone planted permanently at the N. W. corner of lot No 1 at the corner of Main & Town Streets and one at the S. W. corner of lot No 7 Main Street and 2nd alley 3. alleys 12 feet wide run at Right angles with the streets all of which is Represented by the accompanying Plat
