I surveyed for Henry T. Marriott these lands part of Survey N^o 6307 in Delairwood Township Union Co. O.

Beginning at the S.W. corner of Samuel Murphy's land on the north side of the York Center Pike S82 W. along the north line of said pike to a stake. (88⁶³/₁₀₀ poles which makes the Graham street west side direct) Then e N8 W20⁶³/₁₀₀ poles to a stake, making the north line of West Blagrove street. thence N82 E 78³/₁₀₀ poles to a stake in the line of Samuel Murphy. thence S15¹/₂ E. 20⁷⁵/₁₀₀ poles to the place of beginning.

Containing 10²²/₁₀₀ acres.

The same I have subdivided into lot numbering from 690 to 727 of dimensions as marked upon the accompanying plat.

The alleys running north and south are twelve feet in width, the one running east and west is sixteen and one half (16¹/₂) feet in width.

Hastings street corresponds with Hastings street in Marriott's first addition, this and Graham Street are fifty (50) feet in width. West Blagrove Street is sixty (60) feet in width.
