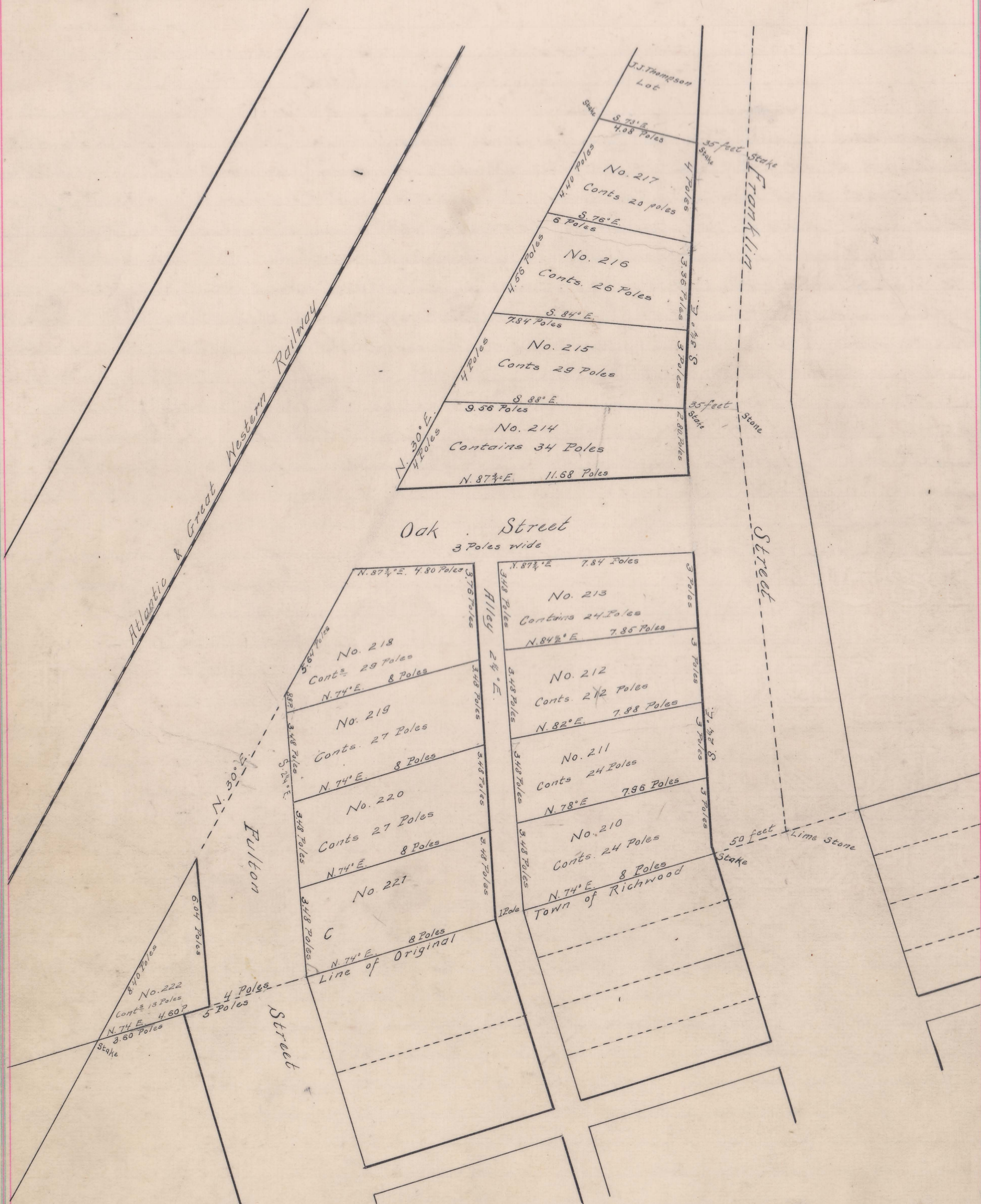

 I hereby certify that on the 20th & 21st days of July A.D. 1865. I made a survey of an addition to the town of Richwood Union County Ohio for H. H. Poppleton and E. F. Poppleton Executors of Samuel Poppleton deceased, of the lands embraced in the following description. To wit: Beginning at a stone in the center of Franklin Street and in the north line of the town of Richwood. thence with the center of the Kenton Free Turnpike. N 6° W. 17.16 poles to a stone. thence with the center of said Turnpike. N 3 1/4° E. 9.60 poles to a stake southeast corner to J. J. Thompson lot, bought of Samuel Poppleton. thence with Thompson line N 75° W. 6.20 poles to a stake southwest corner of said lot & in the line of the A. & C. W. Railroad. thence with the said line S 30° W. 42 poles to a stake in the north line of Richwood. Thence with said line N 74° E 28.6 poles to the beginning. For further description reference may be made to the above plat which is a correct representation of said addition.

F. Roberts by deed duly recorded in Book 20 page 103. Union County Records. except that part sold by Samuel Poppleton to J. J. Thompson. by deed recorded in Book 28 page 29. records of Union County.

And we do hereby dedicate to public use the said streets & alley represented upon the above plat.
