

I hereby certify that on the 15th day of August 1873, I made a survey of an Addition to the Town of Richwood Union County, Ohio of the lands embraced in the following description (Being the same lands known as the "Hamilton Grove" and which Orrin Beem holds under a Bond or Contract of sale from George B. Hamilton and over which the said Orrin Beem holds entire and undisputed control.) Beginning at a stone north west corner to the Atlantic & Great Western Railway Gravel Bank. Thence with the west line of said Gravel Bank S 16° E 106 poles to a stone Northeast corner to Hylas Sabines land. Thence with his north line and also the North line of N. Collier and S. Murphy S 74 1/2° W. 62 poles to a stone Northwest corner to said S. Murphy's land. Thence with the east line of H. T. Marriotts land N 16° W 106 poles to a stone Northeast corner to said H. T. Marriotts land. Thence with the south line of H. B. Hamilton's lands N 74 1/2° E. 62 poles to the beginning. Containing 41 Acres + 12 poles
