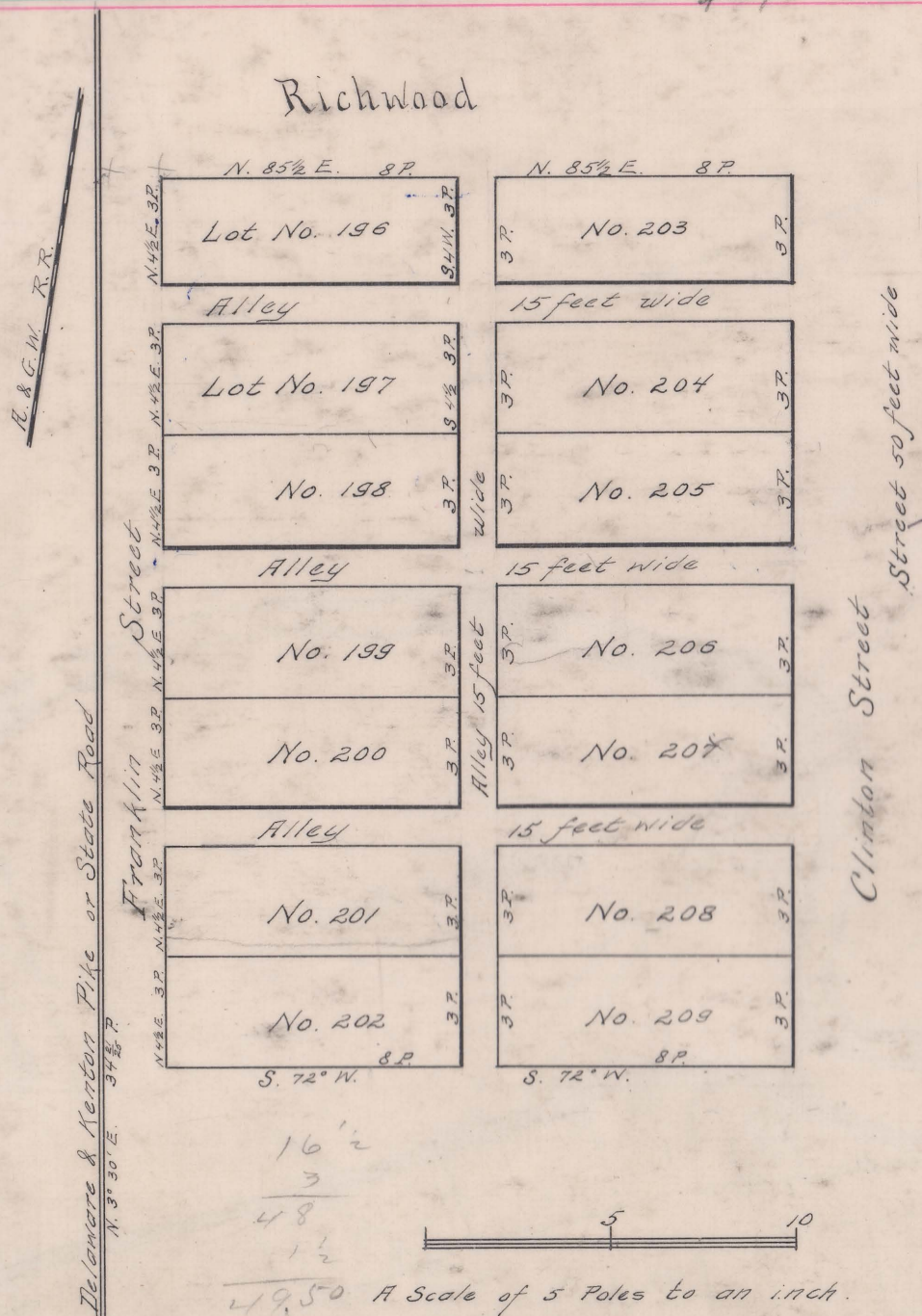

The above is the plat of a Survey made November Nov^r 2^d A.D. 1865 it bring J. Woods Addition to the Village of Richwood bring in Survey N^o 6307. Commencing in the center of the Delaware & Kenton Pike on the north line of the Village of Richwood (at D on plat) Thence N 4 1/2° East 17 poles to a stone in the center of Road (At A on Plat) thence N 3° 30' East with the center of said Road. 34 20/25 Poles to a stone at B on Plat. thence N 72° E. 34 feet to C. on Plat, it bring the north west corner of lot N^o (196). The Balance of said Survey made as Represented by the within Plat, the lines of said lots are all Parallel and of equal distances as shown by plat and is fully described thereby.
