

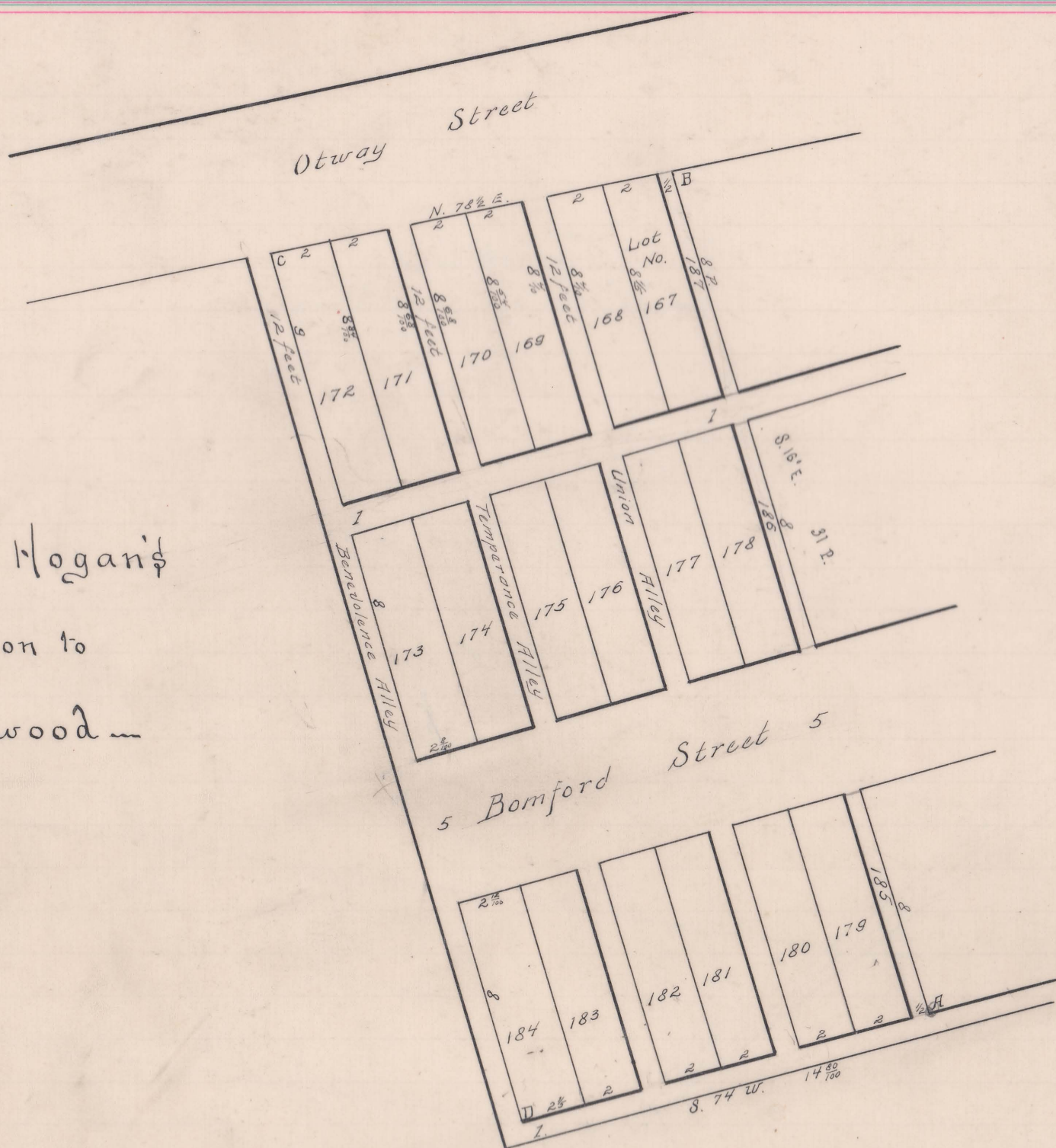

Hugh F. Hogan's

Addition to

Richwood



Know all men that I, Hugh F. Hogan of the County of Union and State of Ohio have laid off the following described premises as an addition to the town of Richwood in said County.

Said addition being a part of a lot of 3 acres more or less conveyed to me by Joseph Parish April 24th 1865 except the land embraced in lots 167, 168, 169, 171 & 172 & heretofore sold by said Parish to Sylvester Brundage.

The lands embraced in the above plat & laid into lots, streets & alleys as represented thereon is described as follows to wit:-

Beginning at a stone with piece of brick under it marked A. on the plat hereto annexed which bears N 16° W. 9 poles from the southwest corner of Out Lot N^o 16 in said town of Richwood. Thence N 16° W. with the west lines of Out Lot N^o 15 & In Lots N^{os} 122 & 85 - 30 poles to a stone with piece of brick under it at the northwest corner of said lot N^o 85 and at the south margin of Otway Street marked B. Thence along the south margin of said street S 78 1/2° W 13.94 poles to a stone with piece of brick under it at the point marked C. course continued 12 feet to the line of said Hogans land. Thence with his line S 15 3/4° E. 32 poles. Thence N 74° E 14.86 poles to the southwest corner of said out lot N^o 16. Thence N 16° W. one pole to the beginning.

Containing 2 acres and 140 square poles a stone with piece of Brick under it is also planted at the point marked D. for further description of the lots reference may be made to said plat.

The plat heretofore made and recorded in plat Book N^o 1. page 271 is hereby cancelled and the one above represented adopted

in its stead. June 2^d / 1865.
