Beattys Addition

Blagrove Street

Surveyed for Edward Norris Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> 1872 an Addition to the Town of Richwood Ohio embraced in the following description. Being part of the lands of Edward Norris lying between an eastern extension of Blagrove & Ottawa Streets, on the east side and ad-

joining the old corporation of Richwood. Commencing at the intersection of Blagrove Streets south line with the original east line of the Buller Claibourne Survey N<sup>o</sup> 6293. Thence with the same course of said street N 73 1/2° E. 30 9/100 poles to a stake on the east side of an alley. Thence with the line of said alley S 16 1/2° E. 28 poles to a stake in an extension of Ottawa Street. Thence due west with the line of said Ottawa Street to the original line of the Buller Claibourne Survey. Thence N 16 1/4° W. 19 1/100 poles to the place of beginning. Containing 4 4/100 acres of land. Two acres of land heretofore included in the corporate limits. Hylas Sabin Surveyor.

Know all men by these presents that we Edward Norris & Nancy Norris his wife of Richwood O. have this day caused to be surveyed an addition to the Town of Richwood as described in the accompanying Plat and Survey which we designate by the name of "Norris' Addition to the Town of Richwood" and we do hereby dedicate to public use all of said Streets and Alleys as represented upon the accompanying plat.
