It is hereby certified that on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 1880. I made a survey and division into lots, streets and alleys of the following described lands to be known as Freshwaters Addition to Marysville Union County Ohio. Being all of the tract of land in survey N<sup>o</sup> 3351 conveyed to William Freshwater by Peter Hush and wife by deed bearing date of April 28<sup>th</sup> 1866. and recorded in book 29 page 188. of the Record of Deeds of Union County Ohio containing 14 Acres and One Hundred and Forty Five (145) poles more or less.




