January 17th, 1855.

Surveyed for Mr. E. Lee. the following lots of an addition to the Town of Marysville and being attached to D. D. Welsh's addition. Lots N^o. 13 & 14 of said Welsh's addition and lots N^o. 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 laying on the West side of a street (laid off 35 feet wide) front to the east on the Street 4 poles and back 10 poles. The lots 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 & 31 and front to the West on the Street 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles and back 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles; each of the lots containing $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre, and an alley 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles wide between lots N^o. 19 & 20.

The course of the street and the back lines of the lots, is N^o E, and the course of lines on the north and south side of the lots is N 89^o W.
