

Deed of Dedication of Olive Street to the
Village of Marysville Union County Ohio

Situated in the Village of Marysville,
Ohio and part of Survey Number 3357.
Beginning in the center of Fifth Street (Witness
stone bears S 85° E. 16.5 feet) Thence N. 5° E. 401.8
feet passing five and one-half feet west and
parallel to the face of a stone curb line as
now located, to the center of Fourth Street
(witness stone bears S 85° E. 16.5 feet); Thence
with the center of said Fourth Street S. 85° E. 33
feet; Thence S. 5° W. 401.8 feet passing five
and one-half feet East and parallel to the
face of a stone curb line as now located,
to the center of said Fifth Street; Thence
N. 85° W. 33 feet to the beginning.

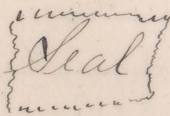
