


"Accepting McEann's Third Street Dedication"

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Marysville, State of Ohio:

Section I. That the dedication made by Ernest G. McEann Trustee, and wife of the strip of ground three and One half feet ($3\frac{1}{2}$) in width along the northern line of Lots No two and three from Main Street to Plum Street, dated March 14th 1907 be and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed for public use as Third Street.

Section II: That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


"Accepting dedication of Park"

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Marysville State of Ohio:

Section I That the dedication of the Six Hundredths ($\frac{6}{100}$) Acres of land at the intersection of Fourth and Fifth Streets made by Isaac Staley at the request of the Civic League of the Village of Marysville, for the Public use as and for a Park of the date of the 15th of April, 1907, be and the same is hereby accepted for public use as a Park to be maintained by the said Village as and for a Park for the use of the Public. To be incorporated together with the lands already by the Village at the intersection of said Fourth and Fifth Streets, as a Public Park reference being had to the said deed of dedication and plat thereof, as executed by said Isaac Staley at the request of the Civic League.

Section II That this Ordinance take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

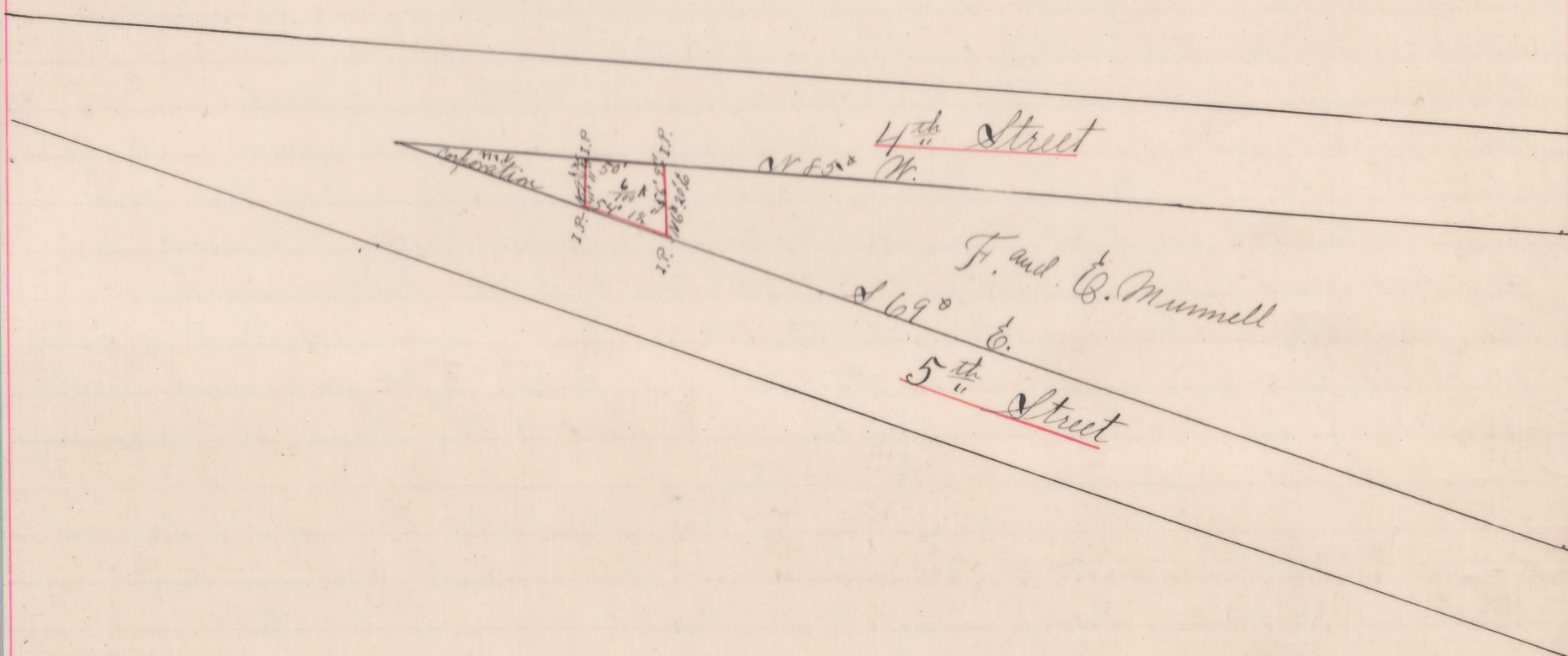
Deed of Dedication, from Isaac Staley to Village of Marysville.

Beginning, at a stake in the North line of Fifth Street and at the Southwest corner of land in the name of H. and G. Mummel: Thence with West line of said land North $6^{\circ} 20'$

East 56 feet and 9 inches to the southerly line of Fourth Street: Thence with the southerly line of Fourth Street North 88° West 50 feet to the Northeastly corner of land with title in the corporation of the Village of Marysville: Thence with the Easterly line of said corporation land South $9^{\circ} 15'$ West 41 feet and 1 inch to the North line of said Fifth Street: Thence with said line of Fifth Street South 69° East 54 feet and 2 inches to the place of beginning.

Being all the lands with title in said Grantor between Fourth and Fifth Streets and between the lands of F. and E. Mummel and the corporation lands, and containing Six Hundredths ($\frac{6}{100}$) acres more or less.

Know all men by these Presents: That Isaac Staley, unmarried for and in consideration of One Hundred and ninety (\$190.) paid by the Civic League of Marysville Ohio, The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and at the request of the said Civic League, hereby dedicate to the Village of Marysville Ohio for the use of the Public as and for a Park, the lands above described as shown on the Plat hereto attached.
