

I hereby certify that on the 14th. day of February 1871. I made a Survey of an addition to the town of Marysville of the lands embraced in the following description. Beginning at the south east corner of out lot No. 29 in said Town of Marysville. Thence with the east line of out lots No. 29 & 38. N 2° E. 24 <sup>24</sup>/<sub>100</sub> poles to a stake. Thence S 88° E. 23 <sup>64</sup>/<sub>100</sub> poles to a stake in the west line of George Gibsons land. Thence with said line S 2° N. 24 <sup>24</sup>/<sub>100</sub> poles to a stake in the north margin of Center Street in said Town of Marysville. 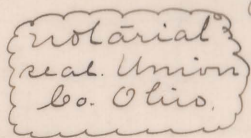
