

It is hereby certified That on the 18th day of May 1876. I made a Survey and Division into Lots and streets of the following described lands to be known as Southwicks Addition to Marysville Union County Ohio.



Beginning at a stone south east corner to Out Lot N^o 28 in the Incorporated Village of Marysville. Thence N 88° W with the south line of said Lot. 10.52 poles to a stone south west corner to E. Green's Lot. Thence N 2° E 10 poles to a stone. Thence N 88° W 20.43 poles to a stone in the East line of out Lot N^o 22. Thence S 8° E. with the East line of Out Lots N^{os} 22-23 & 24, 12.56 Poles to a stake in the south line of South Street. Thence S 88° E. with the South Margin of South Street 9.90 poles to a stake North East corner to Union School Lot. Thence S 2° W 10 poles to a stake North west corner to D. Edwards Lot. S 88° with the North line of said Lot 18.92 poles to a stake in the west line of Mil-lain Freshwaters Land. Thence N 2° E. with said line 12.16 poles to the Beginning. Containing 2 acres and 126 poles. Part of Survey N^o 3351.


