Surveyed for T. L. Skinner an addition to the Town of Marysville Part of Survey N<sup>o</sup>. 3354, as shown in the above Plat. beginning at a stake parallel with the north side of Center Street and one pole North 89° W. from the Southwest corner of a lot of one acre and  $\frac{4}{100}$  of a pole sold by said Skinner to John Cassil. The laying of the lots as numbered from one to five with four Poles front on Center Street and Ten Poles back at right angles from Center Street and an alley of one Pole wide on the north end of the Lots.
