

## Deed of Dedication

Know all men by these presents, that Hal J Yarrington, Ethel Yarrington, his wife and Leo Davis, Helen Davis, his wife are lawfully seized of a tract of land, situated in the village of Marysville, in the County of Union, and the State of Ohio and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a post, southeast corner of a 38/100 acre tract and in the north line of Sixth Street, thence with the north line of Sixth Street N. 85° 20' E 128 feet to a post, being the southwest corner to lot No 717 in Edgewood Terrace Addition; thence with the west line of Lots Nos. 717 and 716, N 4° 40' W 218 feet to northwest corner to lot No 716; thence with the west line of Lots Nos. 715, 714, and 20 feet off south side of lot No 713, N 3° 20' E. about 160 feet; thence S. 87° W 153 feet; thence S 5° E about 371 feet to the beginning. Containing about 1.03 acres more or less.

Also- Beginning at the southeast corner to Lot No. 713 and in Edgewood Terrace Addition to Village of Marysville; thence with line of lots Nos 713 and 714 westerly 95 feet to the southwest corner of lot No 713; thence northerly with the west line of lot 20 feet; thence easterly parallel with south line of lot No. 713 91.5 feet to the east line of said lot; thence southerly with the east line of lot No 713, 20 feet to the beginning, being 20 feet, off the south side of lot No 713.

Also - All lots Nos. 714, 715, 716, 717 and 718 in Edgewood Terrace Addition to Marysville.

Being all the property as conveyed by Fred F Jones to Hal J Yarrington and Leo Davis April 1946, as recorded in Deed Record Volume 173, page 697.

That the said Hal J Yarrington, Ethel Yarrington, and Leo Davis Helen Davis, have caused the same to be surveyed and laid out into streets and lots by a licensed surveyor as indicated by the plat of Yarrington - Davis addition to Marysville to which reference is hereby made for further descriptions and does hereby dedicate to public use all streets as shown upon said plat as being a part of said Addition, and that Lots 714, 715, 716, 717, and 718 are no longer to exist as such.
