Dear Prospective Board Member:

The Greater Gubser Neighborhood Association is currently preparing for our 2014 Association Board elections, which will take place at our November general meeting as directed in our bylaws. This meeting will be held on Thursday, November 21, 2013, at 7 p.m. at Gubser Elementary School.

Nominations are currently open and will remain open until immediately prior to each round of voting. You may nominate yourself for any or all positions by informing a current GGNA board member or speaking up in one of our GGNA general meetings. Prior to the elections, you are encouraged to review our GGNA bylaws for information regarding the responsibilities of each board position. An organization chart of our 2013 board leadership structure is also provided for your reference.

To assist our association members in choosing for whom to vote, we will be preparing a brief voters' guide and request that you fill out the attached information form and send it to Brad Coy at [bradcoy@gmail.com](mailto:bradcoy@gmail.com) or 1722 River Rock Dr NE, Keizer, OR 97303. This form is also available electronically upon request, and providing us with an electronic version via email is preferred.

At our November meeting, candidates will be introduced and then association members will be given a specified amount of time to review the voters' guide and personally visit with candidates in an open format. Then, voting will proceed through each position in the following order:

1. President (voting members vote for 1 candidate, with top vote getter being elected)
2. Vice President (same voting process as President)
3. Secretary (same voting process as President)
4. Treasurer (same voting process as President)
5. At-Large Board Members (voting members vote for 4 different candidates, with top 4 vote getters being elected to the 4 available at-large positions)

While the new board terms will not take effect until January 1, 2014, all elected board members are expected to participate in the November 21 board meeting that will immediately follow the general meeting. This meeting will facilitate any transition of leadership.
