Lewis County DSS offers funding to help with child care costs.

Any parent working or attending school who meets the financial eligibility guidelines below is encouraged to apply.

Eligibility is determined by gross income (see above) and does not consider any assets such as owning a house or vehicle, or having money in the bank.

Children must be younger than 13 years old or have a special need to qualify for care.

Parents have options of providers ranging from licensed and registered providers to even family members or friends.
