**OFA Director Kelly Hecker-**

Kelly stated that the band has agreed to play free of charge for the Senor Day at the Fair.

Kelly will accompany Nancy Jones to attend the 5/22/18 Older New Yorker's Day in Albany for recognition by the Governor as the Lewis County Senior-of-the-Year.

Office For Aging staff have raised donations of \$960.75 for the Alzheimer's Association.

Kelly recognized the substantial contributions by volunteers who donated a total of 38,000 hours, equating \$340,000 annual savings computed at the minimum wage. As an expression of gratitude, a Volunteer Appreciation luncheon was held.

She informed of upcoming June events; Thirsty Painter's paint therapy, Father's Day meal at all sites, Caregiver Support Group and the senior picnic to be held at the Fairgrounds after a 5-year hiatus.
