

**CASSIA CREEK IRRIGATION DISTRICT CONTINUED HEARING**  
**November 29, 2010**

The Cassia County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing today to determine the sufficiency of the petition for the proposed Cassia Creek Irrigation District. Chairman Dennis Crane, Paul Christensen and Clay D. Handy, Board Members; Alfred E. Barrus, Prosecuting Attorney; Kerry D. McMurray, County Administrator; Joseph W. Larsen, Clerk of the Board; Bill Loughmiller proposed irrigation district representative; and Matt Darrington, attorney for the proposed irrigation district, were present.

**CONTINUED HEARING ON THE SUFFICIENCY OF THE PETITION**  
**FOR THE PROPOSED ELECTION TO ESTABLISH**

Proposed Cassia Creek Irrigation District attorney, Matt Darrington presented an amended petition with 33 signatures of the 60 landholders within proposed district to constitute the majority requesting an election in February of 2010 to establish said irrigation district. Prosecuting Attorney Barrus requested verification of the signed names on the petition. He further requested powers of attorney for those signing on behalf of other individuals. Commissioner Handy made a motion to accept the petition as presented, seconded by Commissioner Christensen, followed by a unanimous vote. Clerk Larsen reminded Mr. Loughmiller and Mr. Darrington to notify the Deputy Clerk of Elections, Theresa Woodbury, prior to the November 30, 2010, deadline regarding their intent to proceed with an election. The hearing closed at 9:21 a.m.
