CARDBOARD

Cardboard will now be collected curbside along with all paper products on the designated days. The two primary types of cardboard are corrugated cardboard, used primarily for shipping items and chipboard which is usually cereal, gift, cracker and cake mix boxes, etc. Clean corrugated cardboard should be flattened and placed at the curb for collection. Clean chipboard should be placed at the curb for collection on your designated collection day for Cardboard & All Paper.

ALL PAPER PRODUCTS

Magazines, catalogs, color inserts, envelopes, junk mail, notebooks, chipboard, coupons, school papers, books without hard covers, non-metallic wrapping paper, and mixed office paper. **DO NOT INCLUDE:** Juice boxes, milk containers, dirty pizza boxes, plastic wrapping and styrofoam should be placed in your garbage for collection.

COMMINGLED MATERIALS

#1 & #2 plastics, glass food and beverage containers, tin cans, aluminum cans, plastic soda, milk, detergent and juice containers. Dispose of all other plastics in the regular garbage. Do not recycle plate glass or ceramics.

WHITE GOODS/METAL

Refrigerators, freezers, stoves, hot water heaters, air conditioners, trash compactors, dishwashers, metal desks, file cabinets, bicycles, metal lawn furniture, lawn mowers, metal window frames, and other non-automotive metal items.

BULKY ITEMS

Mattresses, furniture, chairs, couches, chain link fencing, lighting fixtures, bed springs, rolled carpeting and other large articles incident to the conduct of the property, provided the items weigh less than 100 pounds. Remodeling and construction materials are to be disposed of privately by the resident/owner and NOT included with the Bulky Item pick-up service.
