

Verona Landmarks Preservation Commission
Minutes of the March 16, 2017 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm.

Chairmen Houthuysen read the Statement of Compliance.

The minutes of the January 19 meeting were read and approved.

Town survey: Barton Ross will have preliminary survey sent by next month. Will send out in April for comments at the May meeting.

Name change: The new name – Verona Historic Preservation Commission – was approved by the Town Council. Glenn to reach out to Steve to update the website.

Annin Lofts: Glenn and Jane went inside with the developer. Will send out photos of the interior to the Commission.

Landmark plaques: Joe reached out to Jonathan Kinney (NJ Historical Commission). Since neither of our sites are on the State or National register, there are no requirements that apply. Size, style, content are up to the town, subject to Verona ordinances about signage. Standard plaques have name of building, the date it was built and the date landmarked. Glenn is contacting vendors and will get prices by May meeting.

Preservation in Practice Workshop: Will be held on March 18, 2017.

CLG Report: The report has been sent to Jonathan Kinney at the NJ Historic Preservation Commission.
