ORDINANCE # 2017-21

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES, COMPENSATION OF
CERTAIN PAID OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, in December 2015, the Mayor and Council hired Matthew Cavallo as Township Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council entered into an employment agreement with Cavallo that established his salary for the 2015 and 2016 calendar years; and

WHEREAS, Cavallo's employment agreement requires the Council to review his salary and benefits annually; and

WHEREAS, based upon his positive performance evaluations, the Mayor and Council desire to amend Cavallo's employment agreement and fix his salary up to and including calendar year 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Verona, in the County of Essex, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The base salary of Matthew Cavallo, to perform the duties and responsibilities of Township Manager shall be as follows:

1. Effective January 1, 2017, \$135,000; effective January 1, 2018, \$139,050; and effective January 1, 2019, \$143,222.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and the Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute that attached Amendment No. 1 to the employment agreement between the Township and the Manager.

SECTION 3. The base salaries herein fixed shall be paid semi-monthly.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as prescribed by law.
