A meeting of the Derby Board of Police Commissioners was held on February 12, 2018 at The Derby Police Department, 125 Water Street.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Commissioner Pollastro.

1. Pledge of Allegiance

2. Roll Call

Present were Commissioners Pallastro, Lenart and Mancini. Also present were Chief Narowski and Deputy Chief Todd.

3. Public Portion

No one from the public spoke.

4. Adoption of Agenda

Commissioner Lenart motioned to adopt the agenda, Commissioner Mancini seconded and the motion carried.

5. Acceptance of Previous Meeting's Minutes

Commissioner Mancini motioned to accept the 08 JAN 18 minutes and Commissioner Lenart seconded. The motion carried without further discussion.

6. Old Business

Discussion and possible action regarding the proposed Agreement for Jordan Gochros. Commissioner Mancini motioned to accept the Agreement, Commissioner Lenart seconded and the motion carried without further discussion.

Chief Narowski presented a document to the commissioners to look over at their leisure which consisted of a copy of the Executive Summary of the last collective bargaining agreement because we are beginning to go into collective bargaining negotiations again. 10. Traffic Authority Business

Commissioner Lenart motioned to allow the LTA Representative to post “No Parking” signs as needed on both sides of Sodom Lane from John Street to the corner of Marshall Lane to Sodom Lane to approximately 100 feet up to Albert Avenue. Commissioner Mancini seconded and the motion carried.

11. Executive Session

Commissioner Pollastro motioned to enter into executive session and invite Chief Narowski, Deputy Chief Todd. Commissioner Mancini seconded and the motion carried at 6:34PM.

The meeting reopened to the public at 7:33PM.
