No historical item may be removed from the library without permission from the Library Director. The Library has a photocopier and scanner available for in library use of historical photos or documents.

Please read the following copyright restrictions.

The Copyright Law or the United States (Title 17, United States Code) governs the making of photographs and other reproductions of copyrighted material. Under certain conditions specified in the law, libraries are authorized to furnish reproductions. One of the specified conditions is that the photocopy or reproduction is not to be used "for any purpose other than private study, scholarship or research." If a user makes a request for, or later uses, a reproduction for purposes in excess of "fair use," that user may be liable for copyright infringement.


