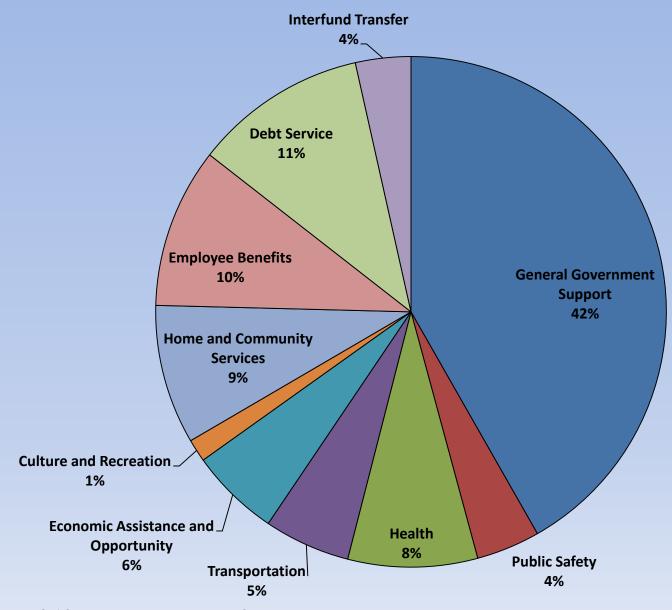

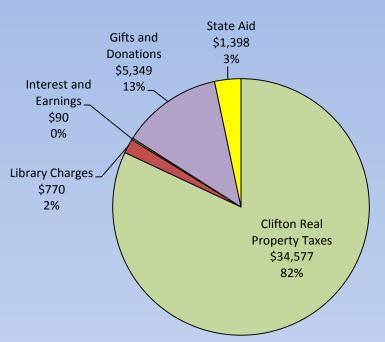
Clifton Community Library

- The library is chartered to serve the Town of Clifton and it is funded with money from Town of Clifton Real Property taxes. The Clifton Town Board appoints Library Trustees. The Town of Fine does not contribute to the library budget. The library is a community resource and available to all who want to use it, including seasonal visitors.
- Patrons: Clifton: 379, Fine: 127, Out of Area: 58
- 10,716 catalogued items in the Clifton Community Library, and patrons have access to 422,678 items in the North Country library system.
- The library was chartered in 1983 and was automated in 2012. It is a member of the North Country Library System. A new book drop-off and pick-up program has started in Star Lake with funding from the Damoth Fund, and there are other drop spots at the Star Lake Community Bank and the Wanakena General Store.
- The Library partnered with the Cranberry Lake Boat Club to build a new pavilion behind the library building.

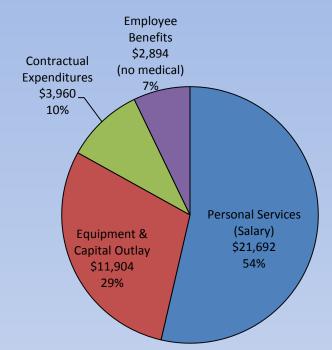

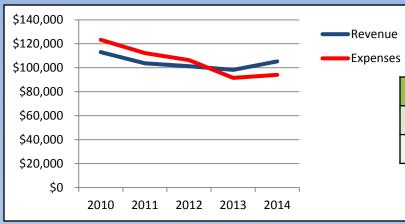

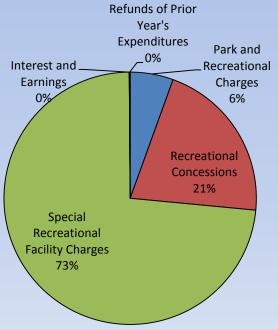

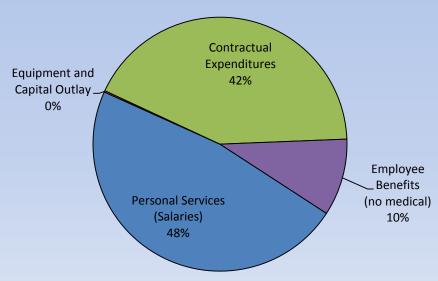
