Local Law No. 4 of the year 2011

A Local Law providing for the changing of Grievance Day to the first Thursday following the fourth Tuesday in May

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Fine, in the County of St. Lawrence, as follows:

SECTION 1:

TITLE

This local law shall be known as the “Grievance Day of the Town of Fine.”

SECTION 2:

PURPOSE

This local law is to provide for the holding of Grievance Day on the first Thursday following the fourth Tuesday in May.

SECTION 3:

AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Section 512 of the Real Property Tax Law.

SECTION 4:

DEFINITIONS

As used in this Local Law, the following words shall have the following respective meanings:

- a. “Grievance Day” means the date on which the Board of Assessment Review shall meet to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

Section 5:

DATE ESTABLISHED

The Town of Fine shall hold Grievance Day on the first Thursday following the fourth Tuesday in May commencing in 2012 and each year thereafter.

SECTION 6:

REPEALING PROVISIONS

Local Law number 1-1994 entitled “A local law providing for the changing of Grievance Day from the fourth Tuesday in May to the first Tuesday in June,” is hereby repealed upon adoption of this local law.

SECTION 7:

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect upon its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
