

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY EMERGENCY WATER SERVICE
TO THE AMERICAN LEGION GOLF COURSE

WHEREAS, an emergency situation has been created by the failure of the dam used by the City of Marshall and the American Legion for road use and water supply use; and

WHEREAS, the failure of said dam necessitated the lowering of the water level in the American Legion pond; and

WHEREAS, water availability is a necessity for the ongoing use of the American Legion golf course; and

WHEREAS, the American Legion golf course is an essential facility for the overall public use of residents of the City of Marshall and keeping it operating serves a public purpose for the residents of the City of Marshall.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Marshall hereby agrees to grant the American Legion golf course a temporary right to use water from the City of Marshall for calendar year 2017 for the sum of \$3,000.00.


IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the American Legion shall be responsible for the cost of materials in having the City of Marshall hook up legion facilities to the city water supply. The American Legion shall be required to maintain its piping facilities so that it does not create leaks or wasted water usage from the City. This service of water under this Resolution shall terminate at the end of the golf season in 2017.
