CALL TO ORDER ~ Chair Jill Bonney-Hill called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

VOLUNTEER APPRECIATION ~ Daisy Hickman, on behalf of the Volunteer Coordinating Committee, expressed appreciation to the committee for their continued dedication and commitment to the City and distributed cookies as a token of appreciation.

ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR ~ Sherrie Gottfried nominated Jill Bonney-Hill as Chair. Kris Adams seconded. Sherrie nominated Kris Adams as Vice Chair. Ashley Wenger seconded. With no further nominations Jill Bonney-Hill and Kris Adams were elected as Chair and Vice Chair respectively by unanimous consent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES ~ Sherrie Gottfried moved for approval of the October 2016 Minutes. Kris Adams seconded. Motion passed as follows: Bonney-Hill, Adams and Gottfried in favor with Wenger abstaining and three positions vacant.

APPEARANCE OF INTERESTED CITIZENS: Kimberly Free, Keizer, suggested that the Keizer Christian Church be designated as a point of interest. She noted that it was one of the first churches in Keizer, built in 1963 at the Albertson's site and moved to its current location in 1980. Discussion followed regarding getting information for the sign and development and placement. Members urged her to work on her research adding that they would assist where needed. The Church would need to pay for the sign, but it could be ordered through the city and, once it is in place, the City could get a Points of Interest sign consistent with others in the city.

OLD NEW/BUSINESS: Jill Bonney-Hill reported that she and Kris Adams had attended the Council meeting to see Anita Zahniser get her 'Volunteer of the Quarter' award.

PROJECTS/REPORTS

Flood History River Marker at Boat Ramp Update: *Flood Sign:* Volunteers are waiting for good weather to pour the concrete.

Status of Geo-caches: Kris Adams reported that there are only four and none are active. She would like to put sunstones in them and advertise them but is worried that people have already been to them. She suggested that perhaps some marketing needs to be done. Kimberly free interjected that Geo-caching is still popular but old sites should be relocated and refreshed to maintain activity. Daisy Hickman suggested that perhaps refreshing and relocating could be done before the eclipse since some of those visitors may participate in that activity.

Savage House: Jill Bonney-Hill urged everyone to look at the websites she had send out several months ago and be prepared to discuss what they would like to put on the sign at the next meeting.

Facebook Page: Jill Bonney-Hill reported that the page is still getting views. Kim Free noted that there are a lot of people who are interested. She urged that the committee post something frequently so that people get notifications and return to the page.

Council Liaison Report: Councilor Herrera reported that Budget Committee meetings will start in May.
